Abstract

You would start typing your manuscript here, after typing in your first heading. But, before you do anything, you should print this page and use it as a guide to align your actual manuscript first page.

Do not change any of the font styles or sizes used on this page. Use the same type for captions above tables and below figures, except apply italics. For example:

Abstract has to be limited to 100 words.

Introduction

You can note that there is only one space between sentences – not two. You can also observe that there is one line between paragraphs and that the paragraphs are not indented. There is one line above and one line below major sectional headings. Make sure your text does not exceed the specified margin at the bottom of the page (0.96 in. or 2.44 cm). Obviously, this text and any guide bars will need to be deleted before you submit your manuscript [1].

Author et al [1] suggested that please check your document for typographical errors and mistakes in spelling and grammar. The “spell check” option in the word processing software can be used to aid in performing this task.

Table 1: The table title is typed above the table using italics. One line appears between the table title and the actual table. Two lines appear between the final line of the table and continuation of the narrative.

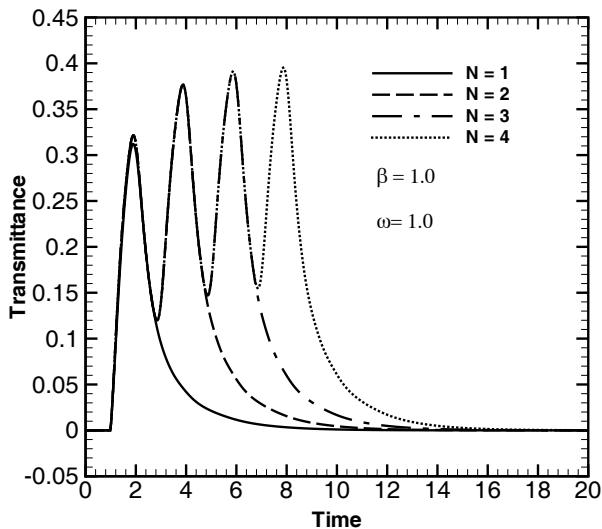


Figure 1: The legend is typed beneath the figure using italics. Two lines appear above this figure and one line appears between the figure caption and the continuation of the narrative.

Arrange figures and tables to allow text to flow around them. All tables and figures must be center-aligned.

Secondary Heading

Secondary headings within a major section should be left justified and underlined for emphasis. They are not in bold font. One blank line should appear above secondary headings and no line appears below secondary headings.

Tertiary heading: Tertiary headings should be left justified and italicized with no underlining. Capitalize only the first

letter of the first word. The text is then continued on the same line. One blank line should appear above tertiary headings.

A column spacing of 0.5 inches is highly recommended since it is easier on the eyes of readers. However, in any case do not change this to be less than 0.3 inches. Do not change the page borders of this American Letter format. Do not adjust the line spacing from this example. Continue in two-column format throughout the manuscript, following all guidelines outlined in this and accompanying documents [2-3].

The “readability” and overall quality of presentation of your research is in your hands. Please take care to prepare a high-quality manuscript that will be an excellent contribution to the AISSQ-2007 Proceedings. It is strongly suggested that you have a colleague read your paper before submitting it. Your manuscript is required to be “camera-ready” and submitted online as a PDF file after final acceptance. Since errors sometimes occur during the PDF conversion process, all files are to be carefully proofed for any errors.

The text, figures, tables, etc. of page two will start here. Once again, it is important that you do not change the top or bottom margins or any other formatting requirements explained on the previous page of this document. DO NOT number the pages.

Continue typing each subsequent page of your manuscript, up to a **10-page (maximum) limit for invited** and **6-page maximum for contributed paper** (that will be presented

in the form of posters) including figures, tables, graphs, etc., following the guidelines on these pages. On the last page of your document be sure the text is arranged in two columns of equal length, as shown here, rather than in a single column to the left of the page. Please note that only electronic submission of the papers is acceptable for AISSQ-2007. Send your paper for review to your regional conference editors. List is available on the website.

Only invited speakers papers will appear in the hardbound conference proceedings. Remaining participants will present their papers in the form of posters and their papers will appear in the CD-ROM proceedings. See the conference website for guidelines on preparing a poster.
